



Charter for Cultural Children of Europe:

This charter describes the general visions for the cooperation in Cultural Children of Europe and the practical goals that make the charter operational.

Visions of the charter

- Cultural Children of Europe will rethink European children's culture so it is based on children's citizenship.
- Children in daycare institutions and in the first years of schools will express themselves in a participation culture that is characterised by children's involvement in experimental, aesthetic processes within art and culture.
- Children in the project will meet adults who invest their own resources and skills by rethinking and developing everyday culture together with the children.
- Cultural Children of Europe will create a sustainable framework for European knowledge sharing, partnerships, and network-based development.

Goals for the charter

- Cultural Children of Europe will create a framework for and support the development opportunities in the work with children, art, and culture.
- Cultural Children of Europe will give 0-8 year-old children the opportunity to immerse themselves in and experiment with cultural and artistic activities in their daycare institutions and in the first years of schools.
- The professional adults in Cultural Children of Europe will participate actively in interdisciplinary networks and gain inspiration to rethink and develop their mindsets and everyday practices.
- Cultural Children of Europe will give all the participating professions an insight into the use of the common methods, experiences and documentation while simultaneously maintaining and strengthening the professional competence of the participants.
